Use of Deicers on New Pavement May Be Harmful

Veenstra and Kimm advises business and residents where newly installed sidewalks and/or driveways were constructed during the 2023 construction season to use sand (plain) for ice melt this winter. The use of sand follows guidance shared recently by The Iowa Concrete Paving Association (ICPA) regarding the harmful effects of deicer chemicals on new concrete pavements. The ICPA advises using plain sand during the first winter after new pavement has been installed to increase the life of a new sidewalk and/or driveway.
